Ages 13-18 Includes: lunch, snack, restricted pool and gym usage, and various age-specific programming (*Capacity 75*)

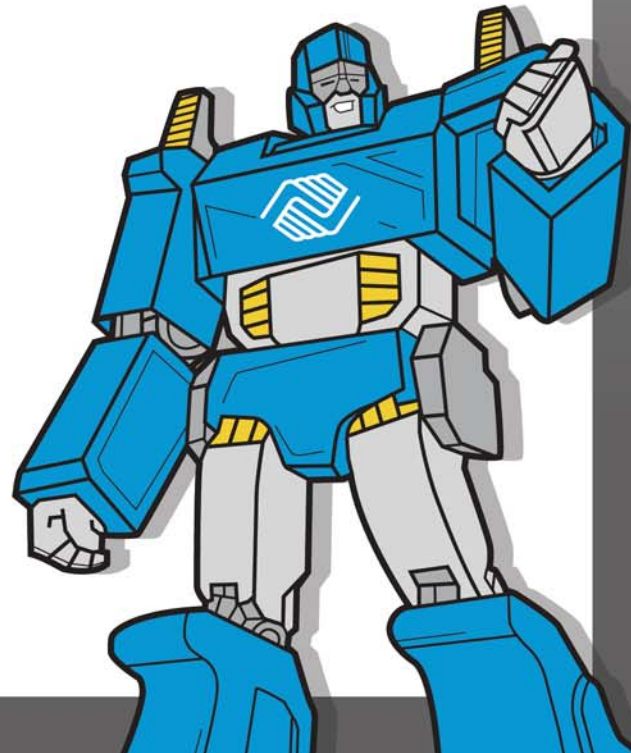
