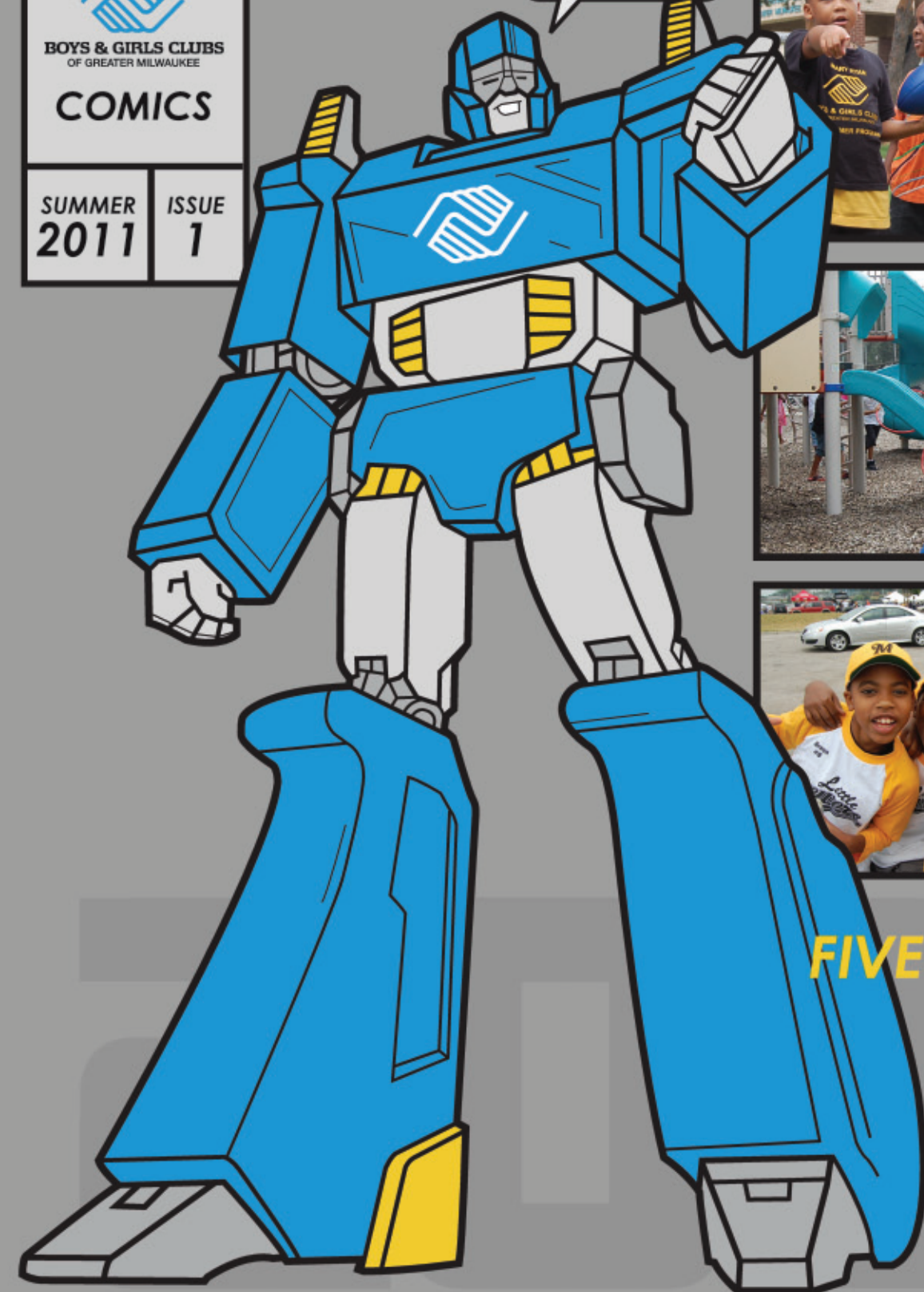

SCHEDULE

Session One – It's in the Game

June 14 – 24

Cost = \$100 (Or no charge if WI Shares Eligible form on pg. 3)
